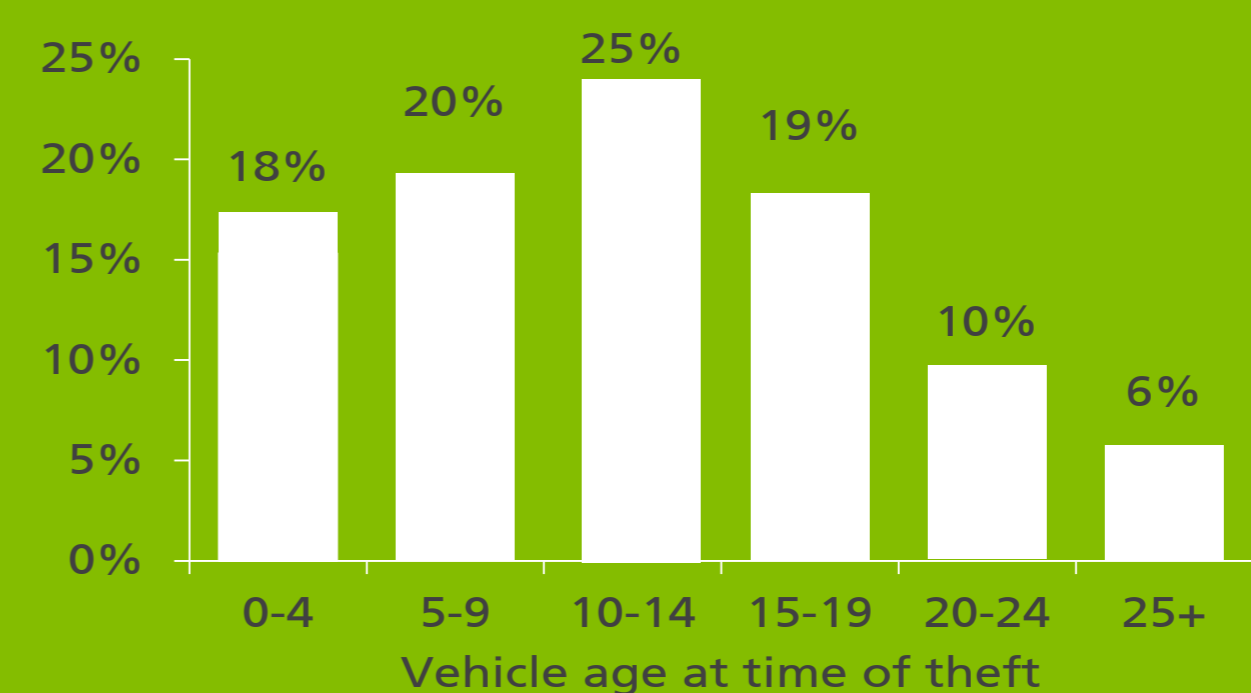

PLCs with no immobiliser have more than **doubled** the theft rate of those with an Australian Standard immobiliser.
